- GC: "My attitude in school was that as long as I wasn't going to get an education, why should these other children get one?"
 - "If God is so powerful, can he himself make a rock that he himself can't lift?"

- AB: "George, a 25 would turn entire continents over!"
- GC: "Now you're talkin', Art! ... It's just wonderful to consider!"
 - "I do enjoy big disasters, and I always hope they're going to be a little bit bigger!"
- AB: "The only reason for that is you've more or less given up on the human race."
- GC: "The problem is when you scratch a cynic, you find a disappointed idealist underneath."
