LINDA MOULTON HOWE

LMH: There is a poor rancher with seventeen hundred (1700) missing cows in Oklahoma (850 cows and 850 calves). ...

LINDA MOULTON HOWE

LMH – started as environmental investigator; former Miss Idaho.

First landing of an earth-made object on an asteroid was by NEAR Shoemaker spacecraft on Eros asteroid.

Dr. Lucy McFadden – Univ. of Maryland geologist interviewed by LMH.

LMH: "What is it that produced the asteroid belt?"

DLM: "We're pretty comfortable with the model: The gravitational force of Jupiter interplaying with the gravitational force of the Sun *prevented* a planet from forming in the asteroid belt. There never was any big planet-size object ... The asteroids are just failed planets."
