JAMES TEMPLAR

AB: James S. Templar is President of the International Guild of Occult Sciences

[AB refers to the guest as “Mr. Templar” throughout the program – never James or Jim. Believe this is AB’s way of distancing himself from the guest’s beliefs – JS].

AB: Mr. Templar says: Magic is real; Witchcraft is real; UFOs are real; Abductions are real.

AB: WARNING! – If you are frightened or unduly disturbed by this material, TURN YOUR RADIO OFF !!!

JT: Maybe demonic entities come from alien sources.

JT: Believes an alien attack against this planet may happen in the next ten (10) years.

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JT: Government suppresses anything that upsets the normal, e.g., Reich’s orgone box.

JT: People are either paid off or they’re killed.

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AB: Are our lives pre-scripted or do we have free will ... or are we led to believe we have free will?

JT: Some people are free spirits who blow in the wind; others are directed.

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JT: If you indulge in drugs, alcohol, and promiscuous sex and so forth, you tend to draw in negative energies.

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JT: There is so much misinformation from occult people: They are frauds – but many of them are honest, yet delusional.

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JT: Nothing can be proven for sure.

JT: The Bible has no credibility whatsoever. But I do believe in a God-form, a Creator ... *not* the Christian God.

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JT: There is no way *all* crop circles can be hoaxes unless there's an army out there [creating them].

JT: Animal mutilation is [undertaken] for genetic material.

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JT: It is not easy to kill someone with magic.

JT: There are definitely good aliens, but they don't seem too interested in helping us.

JT: Denies there was a 'Jesus' ... Not much evidence involved in this. Claims Christian conversion was by the sword, not voluntary.

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JT: Believes Carlos Casteneda is an excellent writer with insight into shamanism.

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JT: Dreams are very deceptive. ... Not much credit you can give to them.

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JT: Believes in eventual Disclosure.

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JT: "If the Bible works for you – 'Great!' – I'm not on a tirade against Christianity."

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JT: There are ways to fight aliens and demonic entities. Grays do not like resistance.

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JT: Claims that Planet Earth is dying.

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JT: Paganism is *not* the 'perfect religion.'

JT: "It used to be that science and the occult were one and the same, and that's what we need now ..."

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JT: The 'Unamazing Randi' is all he is.

JT: Does not have much use for channels ... "I frankly am somewhat suspicious of channels. Period."

AB: "Nevertheless ... is it possible to contact loved ones who have died?"

JT: "It seems that you can ... it doesn't happen every day, but it seems that there are people who can tap into these realms."

[AB finally referred to Mr. Templar as "James" at this point. At least once ...]

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JT: Does not believe our government is Satanic, but does believe there is a "ruling group" [in charge].

JT: Believes the government has secret weapons, and that "it's really hard to pinpoint what's real and what's not."

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JT: Generally does not recommend Ouija boards – attracts low-level spirits.

JT: "Dreams are very unreliable." You have to write them down in order to learn from them.

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JT: There are psychics who can read people's minds [and] can implant thoughts in people.

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JT: We need to get over religion and more involved in nature.

JT: "No quick fixes in the occult, but there are answers."

JT: "Reincarnation seems to be a verifiable fact."

[AB back to Mr. Templar in addressing the guest]

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JT: "Satanists are not Occultists." Satanism is a negative practice.

JT: "There are a lot of bad occult groups, and I'll be the first one to say it."

JT: "Christian sources are mimics of Pagan sources" which came before ...

JS: JT emphasizes the need for analysis of the “voices” (dreams) that come to you.

JT: Very opposed to drugs, but not opposed to shamans – drugs lead to a fantasy state, not reality.

JT: “I believe there are good Christians who are doing good work. There’s good and bad in everything – just don’t shove it down my throat. I support their freedom to operate as much as possible.”

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
