

2006 08 19 Saturday Joshua P. Warren Non-Human Apparitions [Ghosts]

AB: “And one of the things, no matter what your age is out there right now, no matter where you are listening, one (1) of the things ... one (1) of the *very big things* since the inception of Coast to Coast AM has been the discussion of **ghosts**.

And it seems to me there would ... there would be no topic, ah, on [a] program of this sort or really any other program – not that they all touch on it – or that many of them do – should cover, that would be more important than **ghosts**.

So, ghosts have been a fascination for me ... well, always! And of course, this year as always I will do a show on, ah, Halloween – ‘*Ghost to Ghost AM*.’”

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JW: “And by the way, I don’t just study ghostly phenomena. I look at, ah, and my team – LEMUR – looks at cases that are paranormal across the entire spectrum. Because if you, yourself, define what you are looking for, then a lot of times you limit what people will report to you.”

AB: “Um-hmm.”

JW: “Um, but nonetheless after having investigated so many places, **only once** have I *actually seen an apparitional form with my own eyes!*

And, ah, I must tell you honestly – despite having all the data there – if I had not seen one of these [apparitional] forms with my naked eyes, I still would have a lot more doubt about the reality of these phenomena, because it’s just something that, ah, you have to experience for yourself.

It’s like ...”

AB: “Fine.”

JW: “... all the UFO videos.”

AB: “Yeah, yeah ... yeah.”

JW: “You can see the videos every day. You can see the pictures ...”

AB: “I know.”

JW: “... but until you see something personally, it doesn’t really set home with you.”

AB: “I’m very well aware, Joshua.

I, of course have seen my own, ah, UFO *close up*. You know, close encounter of the 'real close' kind. And you're absolutely correct!

On the other hand, I've never seen a ghost."

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JW: "You have to place ghostly experiences and ghostly encounters in context based upon the observer's position to get a full, round scope of the experience.

Whereas even though we may have all this other data we can apply, ah, data in and of itself doesn't really tell you necessarily anything about what's happening if you don't have the human observer there to interpret it."
